Places of Interest

Parks

- **Central Park**
 - A 3.57 km² park in Manhattan
 - The most visited city park in the United States, with 25 million visitors each year
 - Contains a lot of attractions; there are several lakes and ponds, two ice-skating rinks, zoo, the Conservatory Garden and many others
- **Prospect Park**
 - In Brooklyn has a meadow, a lake and extensive woodlands
- **Flushing Meadows-Corona Park**
 - In Queens
 - The city's third largest park
 - Was the setting for the 1939 and 1964 World's Fairs

Central Park



- **Ellis Island**
 - Was the gateway for millions of immigrants to the U.S.
 - Has hosted a museum of immigration since 1990
 - Nicknamed "Isle of Tears" or "Isle of Hopes"
- **Coney Island**
 - Overlooks the Statue of Liberty, New York Harbor, and the Lower Manhattan skyline

Statue of Liberty

- An icon of freedom and of the United States: a welcoming signal to immigrants arriving from abroad
- Located on Liberty Island in NY Harbor
- Designed by Frédéric Bartholdi
- A gift to the United States from the people of France
- A robed female figure representing Libertas, the Roman goddess of freedom
- Holds a torch and a book representing the American Declaration of Independence
- A broken chain lies at her feet

The Empire State Building

- A 102-story skyscraper
- Located in Midtown Manhattan
- With its antenna included, it stands a total of 443.2 m high
- Is generally thought of as an American cultural icon - designed in Art Deco style
- Has been named as one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World

Rockefeller Center



Rockefeller Center

- A complex of 19 commercial buildings
- Built by the Rockefeller family
- Located in the center of Midtown Manhattan
- Home to a number of businesses, companies, shops, restaurants

Broadway theatre

- 40 professional theatres
- located along Broadway in Manhattan
- represent the highest level of commercial theatre

The Metropolitan Museum of Art

- Located in Manhattan
- The largest art museum in the United States
- Contains significant art collections of paintings and sculptures from nearly all the European masters
- Is also home to collections of musical instruments, costumes and accessories, and antique weapons and armor
- Was founded in the 19th century by a group of NY businessmen and financiers, as well as leading artists and thinkers
